

ADULT EDUCATION HEBREW COURSES

Biblical Hebrew (10 class sessions beginning February 4th)

- **Introduction to Biblical Hebrew I** introduces students to the basic skills needed for reading and understanding the Hebrew Bible in a fun, relaxed atmosphere. Focus on grammar and translation will provide the fundamentals necessary to explore the Biblical text, and guide students on an exploration of the linguistic connections, deeper meanings, and subtle humor too often lost in translation. *No previous Hebrew experience necessary.*

- **Advanced Biblical Hebrew** will continue to develop the concepts introduced in Intro I and II. Students who have biblical Hebrew background should plan to arrive at the first class 15 minutes early for placement testing.

ULPAN Modern Hebrew Language (10 class sessions beginning February 1st and 3rd)

- **Absolute Beginner** – No previous knowledge of Hebrew is required. Study with experienced professional Israeli Hebrew educators. Learn to read, write and speak using an innovative multimedia approach.

- **Beginner II** – this is a continuation of the Beginner level from the fall. Students will see improvement in Hebrew reading, writing and speaking skills, and increase their Hebrew vocabulary and grammar.
