# **HEBREW COURSES**

#### Biblical Hebrew (10 class sessions beginning February 4th)

- Introduction to Biblical Hebrew I introduces students to the basic skills needed for reading and understanding the Hebrew Bible in a fun, relaxed atmosphere. Focus on grammar and translation will provide the fundamentals necessary to explore the Biblical text, and guide students on an exploration of the linguistic connections, deeper meanings, and subtle humor too often lost in translation. No previous Hebrew experience necessary.

#### ULPAN Modern Hebrew Language (10 class sessions beginning February 1st and 3rd)

- Absolute Beginner No previous knowledge of Hebrew is required. Study with experienced professional Israeli
