
JEWISH CENTER OPENED

Seminary Official Speaks at Dobbs Ferry Dedication

DOBBS FERRY, N. Y., Sept. 12—Rabbi Max Arzt, vice chancellor of the Jewish Theological Seminary, New York, was the principal speaker tonight at dedication of the new, \$250,000 Greenburgh Hebrew Center at 515 Broadway.

The modern cinder-block and brick building replaced an adjoining outmoded structure in which the conservative congregation had worshipped since 1948.

Rabbi Mordecai L. Brill and Cantor Sidney Rosenfeld of the center officiated at the services, marked by the ceremonial transfer of the Torah scrolls from the old chapel to the new ark, and the lighting of the Eternal Light.

The Center, with a congregation of 215 families, is affiliated with United Synagogue of America.
