

County Library System Offers Records, Films

Adults who have library cards permitting them to borrow books directly from any public library that is a member of the Westchester Library System may borrow as well audio-visual materials, including records, films and pictures.

Records may be obtained at the Chappaqua, Mamaroneck, Mount Vernon, New Rochelle, Rye and Yonkers public libraries. Rules for borrowing records vary at each library. A variety of records is available.

In music there are standard symphonic works, including concertos, light classics and solo recitals, opera and choral music, operettas and musical shows, mood

folk and dance music and some jazz.

Spoken records include dramatic and poetry readings, children's stories and historical narratives and speeches. Study records in foreign languages and readings for dictation and typing practice are popular.

Sixteen mm. films for use by individuals or groups of all ages for informational, esthetic and educational purposes are offered at the New Rochelle library and Yonkers has a small collection.

All films available at libraries in the System will be listed in the film catalog to be issued in October and April by the New Rochelle library and distributed to all member libraries.

Picture collections with prints on a wide variety of subjects, especially selected for use by illustrators, designers, homemakers and artists, both amateur and professional, are available for borrowing at libraries in Hastings, Mamaroneck, Mount Vernon, New Rochelle Pleasantville, Port Chester, Rye and Yonkers. The largest collection is at New Rochelle.

Miss Dorothy N. Lynch, audio-visual specialist, is in charge of these services.

Leukemia Unit Plans Drive

The Westchester Chapter of the Leukemia Society will begin its first fund raising drive on Tuesday, under the leadership of Mrs. Cecil M. Bowling of 130 Pelham Rd., New Rochelle, county chairman.

Sept. 15 through Oct. 15 has been designated as Leukemia Month in many county communities. The mayors of New Rochelle, White Plains, Mamaroneck, Larchmont, Mount Vernon and Tuckahoe have issued proclamations. North Castle, Greenburgh and Tarrytown also plan to observe the month.

The chapter, now in its second year of operation, has contributed \$26,000 to date for research into the diseases classed as leukemia.

About 4,000 county volunteers will take part in the canvass, according to Mrs. Bowling.
