 The members of the Westchester County Board of Legislators, through its chairperson, Edward J. Brady and Legislator Paul Feiner, congratulated the **Greenburgh Hebrew Center** for 40 years of service and proclaimed Sunday, Sept. 20, 1987, "Greenburgh Hebrew Center Day" in Westchester County.
 On that day, a symbolic ground-breaking ceremony was held for the rebuilding of the center. Rabbi Barry Kenter, Cantor Emeritus Sidney Rosenfeld, Cantor Martin Goldstein of GHC, and Rabbi Jerry Epstein, chief executive officer of the United Synagogue of America, spoke.
 Others joining in the ceremony were Gretchen Boyles, second reader at the Christian Science Church, which is next to the Hebrew Center; the Rev. Joe Gilmore, pastor of South Presbyterian Church in whose buildings GHC originally met; and Fr. Hugh McManus, pastor of Sacred Heart R.C. Church, all in Dobbs Ferry; also David Specter, the architect of the project; Congressman Benjamin Gilman; Town of Greenburgh supervisor Anthony Veteran; Hon. Alvin Suchin; and Assemblyman Richard Brodsky.
 The Rev. A. Dawson Teague, rector of **Zion Episcopal Church** in Dobbs Ferry, will

retire from parish work on Sunday, Oct. 18, but will continue to be active in the work of the Episcopal Diocese of New York.
 Fr. Teague grew up in Georgia, was in the Navy for two years during the Korean War, and graduated in 1959 from the Virginia Theological Seminary in Alexandria. He was a missionary priest at the Hudson Stuck Hospital in Ft. Yukon, Alaska, and built two churches in Georgia.
 From 1961 to 1972, he was chaplain at the University of Georgia at Athens. He was assistant rector of Christ Church in Tarrytown until becoming rector at Zion.
 Fr. Teague started a Sunday prayer service with laying on of hands for healing at the Public Health Service Hospital in Staten Island and continued the practice on Wednesday mornings at Zion.
 The members of the congregation will be giving a luncheon party to honor Fr. Teague his final service on Oct. 18. Jean Plank is organizing the party.
Dobbs Ferry Lutheran Church will present Dr. James Dobson's first film series "Focus on the Family." Pastor Larson says that the series consists of "six presentations which contain Christ-centered advice on getting along with yourself, with your immediate family, and with others." The

films will be shown in Fellowship Hall and will be hosted by members of the church.
 The first showing will be on Oct. 18. "How to Raise the Strong-Willed Child" will be the theme, and the hosts will be the Brunning family.
Aldersgate United Methodist Church also in Dobbs Ferry will present a second film series by Dr. James and Shirley Dobson on six consecutive Sundays beginning on Oct. 18 at 7:30 p.m.
 The theme of the new series is "Turn Your Heart Toward Home," and the first film in the series is "A Father Looks Back."
 In August and September, the Pilgrim statue of Our Lady was hosted each week by a different family belonging to **St. Matthew's or St. Stanislaus R.C. Church** in Hastings.
