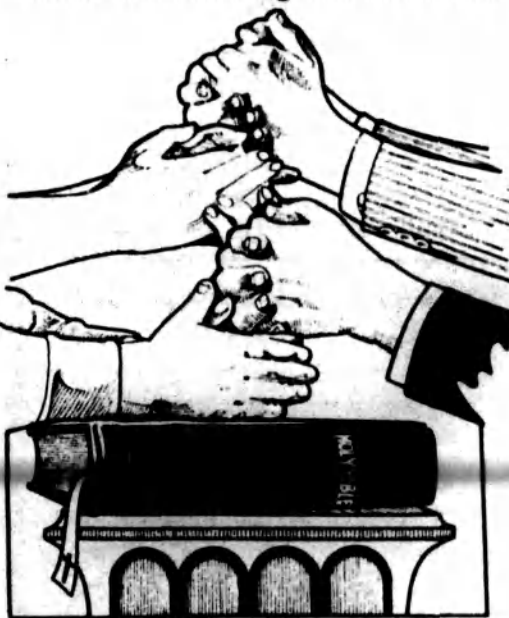

Boscobel Promenade Concerts In July

Boscobel's Promenade Concerts will be held this year on Sunday, July 10, and Sunday, July 17, from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m.

Summer garden concerts, or promenade concerts, as they came to be called, date back to the 1800s. "They went to see as well as to hear. The music must be gay and exhilarating—the scene must be bright, colourful and pleasure giving." These words were used to describe the "Proms," in the nineteenth century, and are today a description of the concerts to be held at Boscobel.

On Sunday, July 10, the **Brass Trio** from the **Bronx Arts Ensemble**, will perform at Boscobel for the first time. The **Bronx Arts Ensemble** was created in 1972, and is

comprised of many of New York's outstanding musicians, who also perform with the **New York Philharmonic**, the **American Symphony Orchestra**, and the **New York City Opera Orchestra**.

The second promenade concert will be held on Sunday, July 17. The **Brass Apple**, from New York City, formerly the **Pomono Brass Quintet**, will perform.

Boscobel is open every day except Tuesday, from 9:30 a.m. to 5 p.m., the last tour beginning at 4:30 p.m. Admission is \$5 for adults and \$2.50 for children aged six to fourteen. Children under six are admitted free of charge. Admission for senior citizens is \$4.
