The Jewish Community Housing Corporation of Metropolitan New Jersey (JCHC) is a nonprofit, 501(c)(3) organization which was founded in 1983 with the mission of providing seniors with affordable homes in nurturing and enriching communities in Greater MetroWest NJ (which encompasses 5 counties in northern NJ). To accomplish this mission, the JCHC has managed, maintained, and operated four apartment buildings which have provided over 450 units of affordable, market-rate and mixed income independent living, assisted living and memory care options in Essex and Morris Counties for close to 40 years.

The JCHC provides additional services to its residents such as meals, social activities, lectures, trips, transportation to grocery stores, shopping centers and cultural events, and chaplaincy services. The JCHC also participates in the state-funded Congregate Housing Services Program, which permits the JCHC to offer housekeeping and laundry services and even an additional weekly meal to the residents living in our subsidized housing at a vastly reduced cost.

The Annual Gala joins over 200 individuals from the Metropolitan New York and New Jersey business and social circles, to raise awareness and much-needed funds for the JCHC.

"Best in Essex" for Senior Housing



The Jewish Federation Plaza is a vibrant 135-unit apartment building located at 750 Northfield Avenue in West Orange. The "Plaza" offers HUD-subsidized apartments for seniors and the disabled who qualify.



At the heart of South Orange is **the Village Apartments**, an 81-unit building to serve moderate income, independent seniors.
Village was the first senior community in South Orange to allow NJ seniors to age in place within their community. Nestled at 110 Vose Ave, Village is just a few blocks away from the local post office, library, public transit to NYC, SOPAC, shopping, and dining.



The South Orange B'nai B'rith Federation House is a 66-unit community where neighbors come together to enjoy all that life has to offer. The community is HUD-subsidized for low-income seniors. B'nai B'rith sits across from a park, next to a police station and within walking distance of the attractive downtown of the Township of South Orange Village.



The Lester Senior Housing Community has won multiple Excellence Awards and sits on the Alex Aidekman Family Jewish Community Campus in Whippany. With assisted and independent living wings as well as memory care suites, "Lester" welcomes all to its 173-unit complex.
