Steven Mandel MD is Clinical Professor of Neurology at Hofstra North Well School of Medicine Lenox Hill Hospital. He is Adjunct Professor of Neurology at New York Medical College and at New York College of Podiatric Medicine. He is past President of the New York Occupational and Environmental Medical Association. He has received the Distinguished Service Award as the Editor of the NYOEMA News Letter. He is a Fellow of the International Association of Independent Medical Examiners, and has received the Presidential Award. He is a Certified Medical Review Officer and a Commercial Medical Examiner.

He has been recognized by Castle Connolly as a Top Neurologist in the New York Metro Region and Nationally. He is in New York Magazine under Top Doctors of New York.

He has written three books on medicine and has authored more than 200 publications in scientific journals. He has served on Guideline Panels for national organizations, including Head Trauma, Opioids and Chronic Pain.
