MERCAZ USA is pleased to pay tribute to Women's League for Conservative Judaism on its $100^{\rm th}$ anniversary.

From the time of its founding by Mathilde Schechter, Women's League has been committed to the Zionist ideal and to instilling a love of Israel and the Jewish people in its members.

In fulfillment of its mission "to reinforce the bonds with Israel and with Jews worldwide," Women's League has sponsored biennial missions to Israel, connecting its leadership not only with the land of Israel, but also with the people – especially those in Masorti kehillot. This connection led to WLCJ providing annual financial support to the kehillot as they established themselves, enabling them to better serve their communities.
